





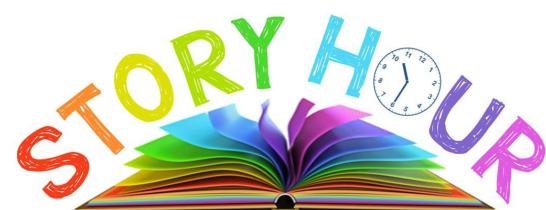

### Kentucky Humanities presents: Eddie Price as Roscoe Tarleton Goose

Eddie Price will present Roscoe Tarleton Goose, one of the most famous Kentucky jockeys to have ever reached and win! Goose was born on a Jeffersontown, KY farm in 1891. By autumn of 1910, he was the leading money winning jockey at Churchill Downs and was one of the top riders in America. In what was a stunning victory, Goose rode Donerail to win the 1913 Kentucky Derby with odds of 91:1, the longest odd of a Derby Winner.

Science in Play2Go is the mobile version of Kentucky Science Center's progressive

next-generation learning experience. It empowers children and adults to learn together, and for life, all through the power of play. Designed specifically for children ages 8 and under, Science in Play2Go is built around the twin concepts of "open-ended play and "loose parts" – materials that can be reimagined in countless ways – allowing children to naturally develop 21<sup>st</sup> century learning and STEAM skills.

With key elements that embody the philosophies behind the Science Center's permanent exhibit, Science in Play2Go will visit libraries across Kentucky for 3-month residencies at no cost to libraries for their visitors. The traveling exhibit is open to the community free of charge.

**Board of Trustees Position Available**  
The Pendleton County Public Library is seeking residents with a passion for libraries who are interested in serving on the Board of Trustees. The Library is a special purpose governmental entity, governed by a five member Board of Trustees dedicated to supporting and developing the Library's mission to connect our community, explore the world, imagine what can be, and create.

This is a non-paid, volunteer position. Applicants must be able to attend regular monthly meetings, currently held on the third Thursday of every month at 6:30 p.m. and lasting 1-1½ hours. Trustee responsibilities include reading prepared materials prior to the meetings; reviewing and approving Library policies and budget; and being an advocate for the Library. The available position will complete an unfulfilled term ending 6/30/2026 and will be eligible to serve one additional four-year term. Selection is based upon diversification, representation of the geographical regions of the county, and developing an array of professional experience that will benefit the Board's decision-making abilities.

Interested applicants are asked to submit an application. These may be picked up at the library. We look forward to hearing from you!
