## UK Healthcare HIV Testing

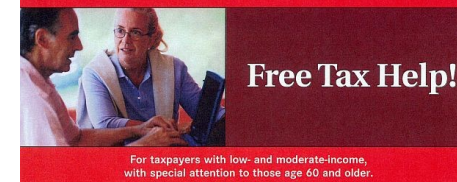

# SIP2GO will be at PCPL from April 15 - July 17.

*Science in Play2Go* is the mobile version of Kentucky Science Center’s progressive next-generation learning experience. It empowers children and adults to learn together, and for life, all through the power of play. Designed specifically for children ages 8 and under, *Science in Play2Go* is built around the twin concepts of open-ended play and “loose parts” – materials that can be reimaged in countless ways – allowing children to naturally develop 21<sup>st</sup> century learning and STEAM skills.

With key elements that embody the philosophies behind the Science Center’s permanent exhibit, Science in Play2Go will visit libraries across Kentucky for 3-month residencies at no cost to libraries for their visitors.

The travelling exhibit is open to the community free of charge.

*Science in Play2Go* is made possible with support from PNC Grow Up Great, and in partnership with the Kentucky Department of Libraries and Archives.



**Blue Blocks:** Large blue foam blocks that invite children to build and create structures both real and fantastical.



**Shapes and Stuff Store:** A unique shopping experience that involves dramatic play while learning shapes, colors, patterns and more.



**Science Depot:** The most programming intensive piece, this experience is based on the tried and true model of Explore, Create, & Share. Topics change weekly, and children are provided with the opportunity to be little scientists and learn about an array of topics.



**Ball Fall:** A large Velcro wall with tubular track pieces and spinning wheels that challenge small hands to construct a pathway for small colorful rubber balls to travel.



**Light Brite:** A large wall, with colored pegs that appear to light up when inserted, allows children to explore their creativity while making pictures and patterns with light.

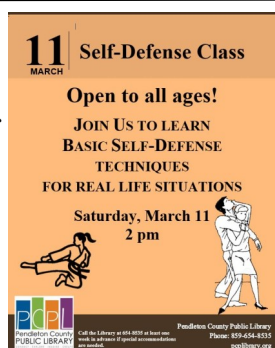
