## **Eclipse Tips and Tricks**

There will be fun projects, Sun Science experiments, and solar eclipse safety tips.

We will also be sharing more details on our Citizen Science project, Eclipse Soundscapes.

"Everyday citizens--even school kids!--gather data or observations of all sorts of subjects (clouds, the eclipse, animal behavior during the eclipse, etc) and submit it to NASA for analysis. Go outside during the eclipse, and just listen and watch carefully to observe anything you can about how insects and animals react to the darkening sky. Once the eclipse passes, write down any observations. We then submit these written observations.

The library applied to be a "data collector" which means we will receive an "Audiomoth" ambient

sound data collection device which we will place outdoors in Pendleton County two days before the eclipse to collect sound data for about a week surrounding the eclipse. Our library will contribute data to NASA!"
