***Program is limited to 40 participants. First Come First Served. No registration. All homeschoolers are welcome. Open to all ages.**

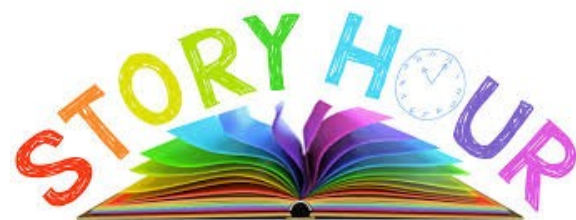

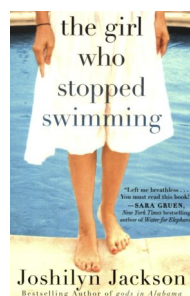
Coffee, Tea, and Conspiracy Book Club adults 18+

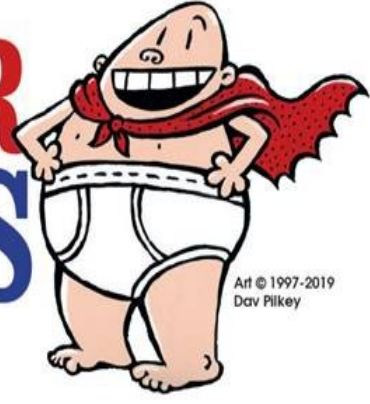
