Summer Reading is Almost Here!

We have begun planning our 2022 Summer Reading Program.

This year our Kick-Off will take place on Saturday, May 28 from 11 am - 1 pm, at the Library with the Newport Aquarium WAVE Foundation African Penguin and Croc Talk. The

WAVE Foundation will bring one of their most beloved penguin ambassadors to the library, where you will enjoy an up close and personal encounter with a penguin. At Croc Talk, learn what it means to be a reptile and have an in-depth conversation about Crocodilians: crocodiles, alligators, gharials, and caimans. It also includes a live American Alligator and a number of crocodilian skull replicas and artifacts. We will be continuing our Activity Kits for all ages during our Summer Reading Program.

Makerspace Afternoon - Stop by and see the 3D printer and vinyl cutters in action and discover how these can be useful to you! There will also be other stations for exploration.

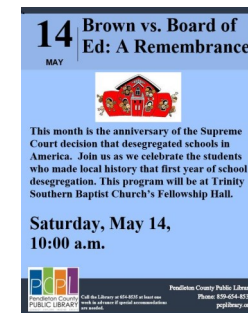
Paint Nights - Show us the artist that you are and share that creativity with the community.

Apply for Your Passport at the Library!

PCPL is now an official Passport Acceptance Facility for the state of Kentucky. What is a Passport Acceptance Facility, you ask? Well, let me explain. A Passport Acceptance Facility is a public sector office that is designated to accept and execute passport applications on behalf of the government. Passport Acceptance Facilities verify the information of applicants and forward the necessary forms to the government for processing.

Passport Agents will be available to process applications on Monday - Friday 9 am - 6:30 pm.

Saturday and Sunday processing will be done by appointment only. No exceptions.
