

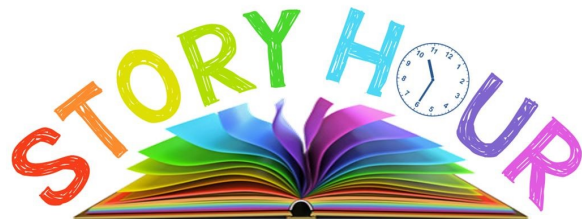

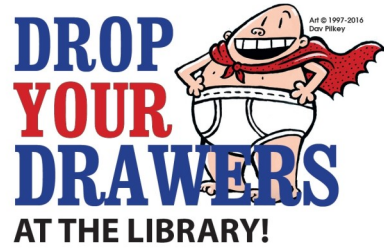


Senior Adult Bingo senior adults age 50+
