Science in Play2Go is the mobile version of Kentucky Science Center's progressive next-generation learning experience. It empowers children and adults to learn together, and for life, all through the power of play. Designed specifically for children ages 8 and under, Science in Play2Go is built around the twin concepts of open-ended play and "loose parts" – materials that can be reimagined in countless ways – allowing children to naturally develop 21<sup>st</sup> century learning and STEAM skills.

With key elements that embody the philosophies behind the Science Center's permanent exhibit, Science in Play2Go will visit libraries across Kentucky for 3-month residencies at no cost to libraries for their visitors. The traveling exhibit is open to the community free of charge.
